## ONLINE FUNDRAISING

**Definition:** any donations given through your fundraising page. Sponsors use the card payment method on the page to give money directly, and the total on your page is automatically updated.

## OFFLINE FUNDRAISING

**Definition:** any fundraising that isn't counted as "online fundraising". This includes cash sponsorship, cheques, and any cash raised by your own fundraising events. Remember to update your fundraising page with any offline donations!

If you have a **CAF account**, you can pay in donations to Hope for Children using your CAF vouchers.

## giftaid it

Gift Aid is a simple way for HOPE to increase the value of gifts of money received from UK taxpayers. When someone donates on your fundraising page, the money they are donating has already been taxed. However, HOPE is exempt from tax so can claim back that percentage of the donation which has already been taxed.

HOPE will receive an extra 25p for every £1 that is donated. Meaning that any gift aid donations are worth 25% more! (This however does not count towards your final total). To find out more, go to...
